Rain Wreck Evidence Checklist

AT THE SCENE OF THE CRASH

Document the weather and road conditions

- Take wide photos of the crash scene
- Photograph standing water
- Photograph missing or inadequate barricades / warning signs
- Photograph skid marks or tire tracks
- Photograph vehicle damage
- Take photos of the other vehicle's license plate and any visible damage

MEDICAL CARE (SAME DAY)

Delayed treatment can seriously weaken or kill your claim.

- Get checked out by a doctor the same day, even if you feel ok
- Tell the provider it was a car crash in the rain
- Follow all medical and aftercare instructions
- Keep all paperwork, test results, bills, and reciepts

INFORMATION TO COLLECT

- Call 911 and wait for law enforcement
- Confirm that weather conditions are noted in the police report
- Exchange information with the other driver(s)
- Get contact information for any witnesses

WHAT NOT TO DO

- Do NOT give a recorded statement to the other driver's insurance company
- Do NOT admit fault or apologize
- Do NOT post about the crash or your injuries on social media
